- 1. October 30, 2015 meeting minutes approved.
- 2. November 13, 2015 meeting agenda approved.
- 3. Evangeline Wong, 2nd year PhD candidate will be a possible designate for Zhara.
- 4. Student Fee Survey Subcommittees-discussion of survey and updates on publicity.
 - a. Management Subcommittee:
 - i. Pie charts are more readable.
 - ii. Need to reconcile the length of survey; it is longer than 15 minutes. Change to wording to not mention length, i.e., "Please take this brief survey..."
 - iii. It may be problematic that certain data is being stored such as race and ethnicity data with a unique identifier, or email addresses. This may discourage students from taking the survey.
 - iv. The survey can have a link to email information that is anonymous for the purposes of students interested in participating in the drawing.
 - v. Can the logos and pictures of campus-based fees be smaller? It helps students to identify with each of the fees and what they are associated with.
 - vi. Should we include the full budget for all SSF-funded units? We can consider this for 2016-17 survey; it's too late to include in this year's survey
 - vii. Move questions 16 and 17 to front.
 - viii. Can the survey be revised so that undergrads and grads can be redirected to appropriate questions?
 - ix. In regards to students' residency, can we ask where they live on campus and what bus lines they use?
 - x. Toggle question with age ranges rather than asking students to input ages, or leave as it? It might be easier to analyze data.
 - xi. The link on page 20 is broken.
 - b. Survey publicity:

- i. Nancy will update flyer
- ii. ASUCI will include a link to the survey in the banner on their website.
- iii. There will be an email created to send out to undergrad students (second blast in January).
- iv. Same for advertising for grad students a campus blast went out to grad students around Thanksgiving.
- v. There will be an image on the ASUCI Facebook page as well as pages for individual people from the ASUCI office.
