

**FAQs for Undergraduate Academic Advisors
Fall Quarter 2022 during the UAW Strike**

1. Will I be able to complete my courses this quarter?

YES. You should continue to attend classes and complete assignments and exams as directed by the faculty member in charge of your course.

2. My TA has told me that I won't get a grade for my courses. Will I be able to complete my courses this quarter?

Teaching Assistants (TAs) do not have authority to assign final grades for your courses. The faculty member is the person in charge of your courses. Please follow up with the faculty member in charge of your course regarding what is expected of you to complete a course and get your grade.

3. Will I get a grade for my course?

YES. Faculty are expected to submit your grades by the Registrar's due dates for this quarter.

4. Will I have to retake one or more of my courses this quarter?

No, not if you continue to attend classes and complete all your required coursework; and get a passing grade.

5. What does getting an "incomplete" grade mean? What do I have to do to remove an incomplete grade?

The faculty member in charge of your course is expected to tell you the reason for assigning you an "incomplete" grade and provide you information about how to remove the incomplete grade.

6. Who do I contact if I'm told that my lecture, discussion, or lab section has been canceled?

You should contact the faculty in charge of the course connected to the lecture, discussion, or lab.

7. Who can I go to if the faculty in charge of my course(s) are not responding to my communications (such as questions about my grades, discussion sections, or labs)?
